# THE JESUS FILES – PART I "Ephesus – The Loveless Church" Revelation 2:1-7

There was a time when the church at Ephesus was thriving and healthy. However, over time the church became spiritually anemic and was in bad shape. What happened to this once vibrant church that caused them to be in critical condition such that their hearts were without love? Today's teaching will answer that question and cause us to do a reality check on the condition of our own hearts.
