- 4. What sources exist, other than the Bible itself, that substantiate the accuracy, reliability, and authenticity of the Bible?
- 5. How does knowledge of the writing of the Bible and its value as a historical document influence/enhance your ability to share the Jesus story?
- 6. Of what value are eyewitnesses in the determining the authenticity of the Bible, of any historical document?
- 7. What would you say to a co-worker who made this statement: the Bible is a thing of the past and has no relevance in today's culture?
- 8. How does the Bible as a historical document compare to other histories and information of antiquity?
- 9. What role does the fulfillment of prophesy have in supporting the reliability of the Bible.
- 10. What is your takeaway from this teaching?
