

THE CHURCH – PART III
“The Flock of Sheep”
John 10:1-13

One of the metaphors in Scripture used to describe the church is a spiritual flock. There are numerous references in the Old Testament that identify Israel as a flock of sheep and God as the shepherd. Jesus identifies himself as the Good Shepherd who tends his flock. This metaphor is descriptive of the intense care Jesus gives his flock, while contrasting the true shepherd with the false shepherds who don't care for the sheep and abandon them when danger appears. Today's teaching will reveal how much the Good Shepherd cares for us.

#1. THE METAPHOR OF THE SHEPHERD AND THE SHEEP, vv. 1-3

- A. The sheep pen is God's people – Hillcrest is a sheep pen
- B. The Gate is Jesus
- C. The thief and robber is Satan – the religious establishment
- D. The Good Shepherd is Jesus
- E. The sheep are believers
- F. The watchman opens the gate – the hired hand

#2. JESUS – THE SHEPHERD HAS A RELATIONSHIP WITH HIS SHEEP, vv. 3-5

- A. Jesus calls us by our name
- B. Jesus' sheep listen to him
- C. Jesus goes ahead of the sheep & they follow him
- D. Jesus' sheep never follow a stranger
- E. Jesus' sheep run from the stranger – they don't recognize his voice

#3. JESUS – THE GATE WE PASS THROUGH FOR ETERNAL LIFE, vv. 7-10

- A. The thieves & robbers are the religious establishment, v. 8
- B. The sheep didn't listen to them, v. 8
- C. The sheep enter the gate (Jesus) and are saved, v. 9
- D. The sheep find pasture through Jesus, v. 9, Ps 23:2
- E. The thief steals, kills and destroys, v.10
- F. The Shepherd gives life to the full, v. 10

#4. JESUS – THE GOOD SHEPHERD WHO DIES FOR THE SHEEP, vv. 11-13

- A. Jesus lays down his life for the sheep, v. 11, 17-18
 - B. Jesus owns the sheep, v. 12
 - C. Jesus protects the sheep unlike the hired hand, vv. 12-13
 - D. Jesus has other sheep (the Gentiles) he brings into the fold, v. 16

- #1. Discuss the nuances of the metaphor in point 1 of the outline.
- #2. How do the characteristics of sheep relate to believers?
- #3. What is significant about the sheep following Jesus as he goes ahead of them?
- #4. What does it mean to recognize the voice of Jesus (vv. 3-5)?
- #5. What is significant about Jesus knowing us by name (v. 3)?
- #6. In what sense was the religious establishment doing the work of Satan – the thief? (v. 10a)
- #7. Discuss the contrast between Jesus giving abundant life (v. 10b) with the above?
- #8. Discuss the difference between the shepherd and the hired hand (vv. 11-13).
- #9. What is significant about the shepherd laying in the doorway at night?
- #10. Who are the sheep of the other fold that Jesus brings into the sheep pen? (vv. 16)
- #11. What insights do you glean from Jesus speaking of his death on the cross? (vv. 17-18)
- #12. What is your takeaway from this teaching?
