"The Purposeful Priority of Prayer" Luke 18:1-8

One of the characteristics of Jesus' disciples is that we are designed to be a praying people. Prayer is a spiritual discipline that should be prioritized in the life of every believer. There is always something to pray about, especially in perilous times such as these. In today's teaching, Jesus gives us a glimpse into what it will be like when he returns and the importance of establishing prayer as a purposeful priority.

- A. What kind of faith is Jesus referring to?
- B. Will Jesus find persistent faith that lends itself to perpetual prayer at his return?
- C. There is a relationship between prayer and faith (James 1:5-8)
