"The Purposeful Priority of Faithfulness" 1 Corinthians 1:7-9

The job market is wide open in America with companies offering signing bonuses and higher salaries to attract good people. Jesus is also hiring. The Kingdom of God is wide open to anyone who wants to work for Jesus. However, like any corporation, faithfulness is a key quality that Jesus looks for in people that he has on his team. Building a church requires faithful people who demonstrate commitment to God and each other. Today's teaching will explain why that is the case.

#1. GOD IS FAITHFUL IN ALL HIS DEALINGS WITH US

- A. God abounds in love & faithfulness, Exo 34:6
- B. God remembers his love & faithfulness to Israel, Ps 98:3
- C. God's faithfulness can be relied on, Ps 26:3
- D. God's people praise him for his faithfulness, Ps 71:22
- E. God the Son will keep you to the end, 1 Cor 1:7-9, 1 Pet 1:4-5

#2. GOD EXPECTS US TO BE FAITHFUL TO HIM

- C. Faithfulness be devoted *(proskarteréō)* to your church, Acts 2:42

- A. Faithfulness is a fruit of the Spirit, Gal 5:22
- B. Faithfulness is a quality of Spirit-filled believers
- C. Faithfulness is necessary to build a church

#4. GOD EVALUATES OUR FAITHFULNESS

- A. In this life: be faithful with little & God gives you more, Luke 16:10-12, Mat 25:21, 23
- B. In the next life: The Judgment Seat of Christ, 2 Cor 5:10

- 3. What is significant about God remembering his faithfulness to Israel?

- 5. Why should we praise God for being faithful to us?
- 6. In what sense will the Lord keep us to the end of the age? (1 Cor 1:7-9)
- 7. Discuss the implications of the word devoted from Acts 2:42.
- 8. If a very gifted person isn't faithful in discharging her duties, how does that effect the church?
- 9. Discuss the implications of being faithful with little before God gives you more. (Luke 16:10-12, Mat 25:21, 23)
- 10. How should knowing that we face the Lord at the Judgment Seat of Christ incentivize us to be faithful? (2 Cor 5:10)
- 11. How do cultural trends in America inhibit faithfulness, reliability, and commitment?
- 12. What is your takeaway from this teaching?
