BREAKING OUT OF LEGALISM – IV "The Biblical Criteria of Spiritual Maturity"

If there was a pill that could cure the disease of legalism it would be a strong dose of sanctification, which describes the process we are going through as we grow spiritually. The legalists have drifted off course by pointing to the absence of or presence of certain behaviors that make someone a mature believer. Unfortunately, the criteria they point to are not always Biblically based. It is imperative for every believer to know what picture the Bible paints of a mature Christian, which is the focus of today's teaching.

#1. THE CURE FOR LEGALISM IS A PROPER UNDERSTANDING OF SANCTIFICATION, 1 Thess 4:3

- A. Sanctification defined: to be separated from sin and become more Christlike
- B. Sanctification is progressive throughout one's life
- C. Sanctification is different for every person

#2. THE CURE FOR LEGALISM IS A PROPER UNDERSTANDING OF SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES, Phil 2:12-13

- A. We workout our salvation / sanctification
- B. We have God working in us to transform us
- C. Sanctification is a cooperative effort with God
- D. God's role is dominant, ours is secondary

#3. THE CURE FOR LEGALISM IS A PROPER UNDERSTANDING OF THE ROLE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, Eph 5:18

- A. The command to be filled with the Holy Spirit, Eph 5:18
- B. The conflict between the Spirit and the flesh, Gal 5:16-18
- C. The believer lives in tension, Gal 5:17

- B. The acts of the sinful nature are obvious they divide
- C. The fruit of the Spirit unify people
- D. The fruit of the Spirit are character traits displayed by Jesus, John 15:1-5
- E. The fruit of the Spirit are not exhaustive

- 10) What is the difference the legalists view of spiritual maturity and the non-legalists view?
- 11) What is your takeaway from this teaching?
