One roadblock to experiencing a deeper relationship with God is idolatry. American culture is filled with idols: rock stars, athletes, movie stars, cars, careers, and so on. The prophet Ezekiel was sent to address the sin of idolatry that existed in the Southern Kingdom, which was so severe that God's judgment came upon them.
