When someone invents an item they make a prototype, which is the first of its kind. Adam and Jesus were prototypes of different bodies: Adam the natural body and Jesus the spiritual body. In today's teaching, we gain more insights into the glorified body, and how vastly superior it is to the natural body that Adam was created with. When will we receive our glorified bodies? What kind of bodies do deceased believers have? Where do I go when I die? All these questions will be answered and more in today's message.
