### PAUL, 1 Timothy 1:12-17

- A. We must not live in denial of reality
- B. We must not live in self-deception
- C. We must walk in God's forgiveness

### **#2. WE MUST BE HONEST WITH GOD – THE EXAMPLE OF**

### DAVID, Psalm 51, 1 John 1:9


### A. We must confess our sins daily

- B. We must repent of our sins as needed
- C. We must keep our conscience clear

### **#3. WE MUST BE HONEST WITH ONE ANOTHER – THE EXAMPLE**

### OF RESOLVING CONFLICT, Eph 4:15, 25-27

- A. We must speak & live truthfully, Eph 4:15
- B. We must put of falsehood & speak truth, Eph 4:25
- C. We must not let anger poison us, Psalm 4:4 Eph 4:26
- D. We must not give the devil a foothold (topos), Eph 4:27



The above diagram demonstrates the need to have the right combination of love, knowledge and wisdom in our communication with people.

#10. Why is it important to have the right combination of love, knowledge and wisdom in a conversation?
