Prayer is a dialogue with God, which means that we talk to him and he talks to us. How do we hear the voice of God? Exactly how does God speak to us? How does God communicate his answers to our prayers? Today's teaching will help us understand the different ways God talks to us.

- #7. Read Acts 2:17-18 and discuss the implications of how God speaks to us and may answer prayer.
- #8. Has God spoken to you through other people? Explain
- #9. Discuss the implications of how speaks to us after reading the conversation Jethro had with Moses. Exo 18:17-23
- #10. What does it mean when the Bible says the Holy Spirit bears witness to our spirit? (Point #5 on the outline)
- #11. What is your takeaway from this teaching?
