THE 30-DAY PRAYER CHALLENGE "How to pray: The Lord's Prayer" Matthew 6:1-13

It's amazing that the main time that we pray as believers are when we are in a time of struggle. We are going through a painful time in life or we are concerned for those around us who are going through tough times. Yet we have many opportunities to pray for the opposite. When things are going well, when God's blessings are over flowing. A healthy prayer life is centered in following all of these aspects; we praise God for who He is, we pray for His will to be done, we thank Him for all that He gives us, and we ask Him to forgive us and lead us to Him. Today, we will be looking into how to pray and what the importance of each step is.

Point 1 - Honor God (Matthew 6:1-6)

A. Righteousness is not for personal accolades, it is for the glory of God.

- B. Do not practice in public to be seen
- C. Pray (give) to the needy without announcement
- D. Do not give with ulterior motives-God knows all
- E. God will bless you, that's all you need

Point 2 - Speak less, God knows (Matthew 6:7-8)

- A. Many words can be bad, talk to God only
- B. Don't talk to hear the sound of your voice
- C. Be secluded, be with God
- D. Do not keep babbling; our Father knows

Point 3 - How to pray (Matthew 6:9-13)

- A. Jesus gave us directions on how to pray
- B. Glory be to God-PRAISE
- C. May His will be done here as it is in heaven
- D. Your blessings are what sustains us
- E. Forgive us
- F. Help us to forgive
- G. Save us from our sins
