Today is day 29 of the 30-day prayer challenge. As we've been praying, we have been occasionally reminded of the need to repent of our sinful ways. There is a relationship between prayer and repentance. From time-to-time we need to do a spiritual house-cleaning by taking a look at ourselves in the mirror and clean up our act. Are there indicators in my behavior which demonstrate that my walk with the Lord isn't what it should be? Does my behavior reveal that there are things that I need to repent of? Today's teaching will answer these questions.
