GOD WITH US – PART I "The New Creation" John 1:1-18

In the prologue to John's gospel we have a summary of the Christmas story. This is one of the most theologically rich passages of Scripture in the entire Bible. It depicts Jesus as the Creator, the light that offers salvation, his rejection, and more. With the appearance of Jesus we have the beginning of God's new creation. A new day has arrived in the history of the redemption of humanity. Everybody is invited to receive what Jesus offers.

#1. THE NEW CREATION CAME ABOUT THROUGH JESUS—THE WORD, vv. 1-5

- A. The word (logos) is borrowed from Greek philosophy
- B. The word has no beginning he is eternal, Gen 1:1
- C. The word is fully God, v. 1
- D. The word is the Creator of everything out of nothing, Gen 1:1, 1 Cor 8:6; Col 1:16; Heb 1:3; Rev 3:14
- E. The word is light & life for all humanity, Gen 1:3, 2:7
- F. The word overcomes the darkness cosmic conflict, v. 5

#2. THE NEW CREATION WAS ANNOUNCED BY JOHN THE BAPTIST, vv. 6-8

- A. John was sent by God to prepare the way of the Lord, Isa 40:3, Mark 1:1-3
- B. John called people to repentance, Mark 1:4-6
- C. John pointed people to Jesus, Mark 1:7-8
- D. John & Jesus were related, Luke 1:36
- E. John was born 6 months before Jesus, Luke 1:26
- F. John is the greatest prophet, Luke 7:28

#3. THE NEW CREATION IS VASTLY SUPERIOR TO THE PREVIOUS ERA OF REDEMPTIVE HISTORY, vv. 9-14

- A. Jesus offers light to everyone, v. 9, 2 Pet 3:9
- B. Jesus the Creator became a creature, v. 10
- C. Jesus was rejected by his own he was crucified, v. 11
- D. Jesus offers the new birth to those who believe & receive him, v. 12, John 3:3, 5
- E. Jesus brings us into the family of God, vv. 12-13
- F. Jesus became flesh & dwelt (pitched his tent) among us, v. 14
- G. Jesus is the shekinah glory of God, v. 14

#4 THE NEW CREATION FEATURES UNLIMITED GRACE, vv. 15-18

- A. John decreased as Jesus increased, v. 15
- B. Jesus gives more grace on top of grace already given, v. 16
- C. Jesus is contrasted with Moses a new era grace & truth, v. 17
- D. Jesus being God has revealed God the Father, v. 18, Exodus, 33:18-23, John 14:9

- #10. Moses asked God to reveal his glory him (Exo 33:18f). How does that relate to v. 18?
- #11. What is your takeaway from this passage?
