HAPPY NEW YEAR: THE NEW COVENANT REMAINS Hebrews 9:11-28

As we look forward to the New Year of 2023, a lot of us and people we know are making New Year's Resolutions. These resolutions are mostly based upon making better life choices; eat healthier, exercise more, give up caffeine, be more fiscally responsible....the list is endless. How often though have we or someone we know, made a resolution and failed epically or almost immediately? This message is not to beat anyone up; we have all been there. We have all fallen short of commitments we've made to ourselves and to others. Today, we are going to look at the resolution, the commitment the New Covenant that God made to His people, and how it will never fail.

POINT 1. GOD SENT JESUS AS THE HIGH PRIEST - GOD SENT JESUS TO BE OUR SPIRITUAL <u>LEADER</u>. (Hebrews 9:11-13)

- A. He came as the High Priest of the good things that were already here
- B. He went through the more perfect tabernacle (not man made)
- C. He entered the tabernacle of His own will

POINT 2. GOD SENT JESUS TO BRING ABOUT A NEVER ENDING COVENANT - GOD GAVE US JESUS AS A <u>MEDIATOR</u> OF HIS NEW COVENANT (Hebrews 9:14-15)

- A. Jesus offered Himself as a sacrifice for ALL sin
- B. How much more can our conscious be cleansed
- C. He offered Himself so that we could serve God
- D. Jesus has restored eternal inheritance to ALL

POINT 3. THE IMAGERY OF BLOOD SACRIFICE, (Hebrews 9:16-22)

- A. Under the Old Covenant, literal sacrifices were needed to be cleansed of sin
- B. The copies of Heaven are better sacrifices
- C. God sent Jesus

POINT 4. GOD SENT JESUS TO BRIDGE THE GAP BETWEEN HEAVEN AND EARTH - JESUS WOULD ENTER <u>HEAVEN</u> TO ATONE FOR OUR SINS, (Hebrews 9:23-28)

- A. Jesus did not need to sacrifice Himself more than once
- B. Jesus was fully God and fully man
- C. Just as we are destined, so was Jesus
