The most sacred ground on earth is the Temple mount, where Jesus will eventually go. He pauses at Bethphage, as he plans his entrance into the city. How will Jesus present himself? What kind of King will Jesus be? Will the religious establishment welcome him as their Messiah? What about the crowds of people that have followed him?
